HOSPITALITY and OTHER PERSONAL BENEFITS

All employees and Governors of St Margaret Clitherow are covered by this policy. The Governors have a responsibility to ensure that all employees and Governors act with honesty and integrity when performing their duties. In order to maintain an excellent relationship with all of our users, the Governors need to show that their decisions are made on a proper basis and that judgements are made correctly uninfluenced by any gift, hospitality or other personal benefit, that might be considered to be a bribe or an inducement to act improperly.

Employees or Governors of St Margaret Clitherow who are found to have broken the above principal may be subject to disciplinary action.
